SUMMER TOURS 2008

All grant awarded in the Summer Tours Fund 2008 should have been spent by the 1st November and as such any remaining unspent grant that has not been accounted for should now have been removed and returned to the Exec Reserve.

WINTER TOURS 2008

The table below shows the total amount awarded to each tour that applied to the Union Tours Fund at last CSB. The clubs have now all been emailed with their final allocations. Funding has jumped up to £220 per head in this case with all clubs maxing out at their maximum funding level, except for Riding and Polo who maxed out earlier. Reasons for this includes the extra funding, the number of clubs who were unfundable and French soc who deferred their tour to the spring. I expect the funding per head to drop during the spring tours.

The £8875 has been awarded and should now have reached your clubs accounts. It is likely that some of this shall return, due to conditions not being met, number of ICU students on tour not met and the four week deadline not being met. If so, the returned grant shall be split across the Spring and Summer pots in a 1:2 ratio.
