

Motion to approve the new Liberation and Community Policy

Proposer: Shervin Sabeghi, Deputy President (Welfare)

Seconder: Abhijay Sood, President

Union notes:

1. On January 21st, Council voted to approve the creation of Liberation and Community Networks and the creation of a new Working Class Officer. This paper also mandated the Deputy President (Welfare) to produce a policy incorporating these changes by the end of the academic year.
2. Since this approval, there have been discussions to decide the details of this policy including:
 - a. Consultation with relevant CSPs
 - b. Discussions at CWB
 - c. Engagement with LCOs around specific roles to introduce
3. The role descriptions of the LCOs used to be contained in the Representation Policy, but this has since been removed in the review of this policy.

Union believes:

1. A self-contained policy is necessary to ensure the new networks are able to be a distinct part of Union activity and to finalise certain details.

Union resolves:

1. To approve the Liberation and Community Policy, as appended.
